Dear Brethren:

Westview's purpose is to provide a safe Christian home for young men with hard backgrounds. Our young men come from environments of abuse, neglect, or from adoptive parents looking for help to understand their child.

Here at Westview, our caregivers supply the family structure that our young men are looking for. Over the years, we have learned that helping the child is only part of the solution.

We need to help the parents as well by supplying family counseling, parenting classes, and other interventions. We have developed Westview Family Services to provide counseling, training, and preventive care. Through WFS, our counselors work with the families of the boys in our care as well as with families that are trying to keep their children at home. We also provide parenting classes and trauma training for schools and churches. Our goal is to share the information that we have learned over the years and through our research.



Most of our young men have not known what a well-balanced meal is all about, having lived on whatever they could find to sustain themselves, most of the time with empty calories that do not supply the nutrition needed for healthy bodies. Without the generous support of many like you, our young men would not receive the security and guidance they need so much. They have a hunger for physical nourishment as well as emotional security.
