EDITORIAL

The Church's Purpose

Most of us are familiar with the Great Commission in the Gospel of Matthew. But did you know that there is a version of the Great Commission in each account of the Gospels? Since the mission statement is stated in some way in each book, it ought to stress the importance of fulfilling this mandate. Here are the four statements:

Matthew 28:18b-20- "All authority has been given to Me in Heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Mark 16:15-16-"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned."

Luke 24:46-47-"Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem."

John 21:21-"Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

In each of these

verses are four important elements: **Expectancy**-Jesus didn't offer this command as an option, but as an expectation for this who are followers of

His. Being a part of

Jesus didn't offer the Great
Commission as an option, but as
an expectation. Being a part of
ministries doesn't exclude us from
this expectation.

"ministries" does not exclude us from His expectation to fulfill this purpose.

Sameness-In the same way that Jesus fulfilled the purpose of the Father (and aren't we all thankful He did), we are to do likewise. To have a different agenda doesn't model the example of Christ.

Urgency-If we don't go, who will? The Apostles died nearly two thousand years ago. Knowing they wouldn't exist forever is why the Apostles stressed the importance for the church to carry on in this mission. If the local church makes no effort to evangelize, it is already in a dying state.

Results-The power is in the Gospel message. It is the message by which we are saved. The Gospel hasn't lost its power, no matter how much we believe society is opposed to it.

The church body must be united in this effort and actively a part of it. It's what Jesus commanded us to do.

Are We Too Comfortable?

Is it EVER okay for God to put us into an uncomfortable situation? For many Christ followers we speak and urge obedience, but when some of us are threatened to leave the comfort of our Christian lives, we back down. How do we become people whose faith allows us to walk on water or speak to Pharaoh? It should be our desire to win souls for Christ, thus fulfilling our purpose as God's church.
