

EDITORIAL

"Tell His Disciples...and Peter"

In the Gospel of Mark, after Jesus has been crucified and buried, Mary Magdalene, Salome, and Mary the mother of James come to the tomb with spices to anoint Him. They discover the stone rolled away and the tomb empty. They see a young man, dressed in a white robe sitting at the side of the tomb and are alarmed. He tells them, "Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see him, just as he told you." (Mark 16.6-7)

Remarkably, Jesus has been resurrected, and this news needs to be shared with his disciples. Of course, in *Mark 14*, Jesus also predicted that His disciples would desert Him in the moment of crisis and specifically told Peter that he would desert Him by denying Him three times. That had also come to pass (*Mark 14.66-72*). The different gospel accounts (including Mark) are quite clear that Peter is devastated by his denial of Jesus once he really comes to grips with what he has done. I wonder if he even considered himself a disciple anymore.

The messenger at the tomb seems perceptive of all of this. "Go tell His disciples," he says, "and Peter." Perhaps Peter is separate because he is no longer one of the disciples. Perhaps it is just a repetition of what happened on the night of Jesus' betrayal and arrest. Then, it was predicted that all of the disciples would desert Jesus, but Peter is singled out as the one who will deny Him three times. Now, all the disciples are invited to meet the resurrected Christ, but Peter, the one who failed so spectacularly, is singled out with a special invitation.

I imagine that being singled out on the night of Jesus' betrayal was awkward and awful for Peter. But now, to specifically be included in the invitation to meet the resurrected Christ? That must have been so reassuring: despite Peter's past failures, Jesus still wanted to see him.

Today is Easter, the church's celebration of the events chronicled in Mark 16. Christians around the world proclaim the message that the women at the tomb were told to share. It is a day of joy, celebration, and hope. In the midst of a world plagued by Sin and Death, the resurrection reminds us that Death does not get the last word, and will indeed be defeated someday. There is a sense of triumphalism surrounding Easter, and that is appropriate because Jesus the Christ certainly triumphed.

But there are many out there who perhaps feel on Easter similarly to how Peter felt on the Sunday of the Resurrection. There are many who have followed Jesus at one point, but perhaps deserted Him when things got too difficult. Maybe they denied Him to their peers, or quit following Him because they feared death—if not literal death, the death to self that true discipleship requires. For those in this category, Easter possibly brings feelings of guilt and shame similar to those experienced by Peter.

Such feelings are not necessary, however, because the Good News of the empty tomb is for disciples...and Peter. If you have failed and, perhaps, failed so spectacularly that you feel that there is no place for you among followers of Jesus any longer—be reassured. The invitation to meet and follow the resurrected Christ is for you, too. Just like Peter.

SERMON NOTES

What if it's true?

In logical reasoning, as well as (from my understanding) computer programing, there is an acronym that is widely used. It is IFTTT or "If this, then that." While I have no idea what it means in the computer world (ask one of our many distinguished engineers in the congregation), in logic it has a very simple meaning: if this one thing is true, then that must mean this other thing is also true. For instance, Del City is in Oklahoma, therefore, if Garrett lives in Del City, then he also lives in Oklahoma. This Easter Sunday, we are going to put this logic equation to work and ask the question, "If the resurrection of Jesus Christ is in fact true, what else must be true?"


