 1. **Missing the Mark (Khata):** Asking the question, "Is this a _____ of the King?"

II. The Three Movements of Confession

1. **The Upward Movement** Confession must be _____.
When done well, it leads to the awareness that **God's** _____ is deeper than your mess.
2. **The Inward Movement** This is an honest look at the self that requires the courage to **stop making** _____.
3. **The Outward Movement** "Confess your sins to **each other** and pray for each other so that you may be _____"
(James 5:16).

1. **Turn Inward:** Look honestly at the self.
2. **Be Specific:** Do not make excuses.
3. **Confess to Others:** Bring your secrets into the light.
4. **Accept Forgiveness:** Receive the grace offered.

❖ **Auditorium: Book of 1 Samuel (Garrett Marshall)**

What does it actually mean to have a 'heart after God'?

This quarter, we're diving into **1 Samuel**, a book packed with enough drama, political intrigue, and spiritual crossroads to rival any modern epic. We'll follow the transition of a nation—from the faithful prayers of a mother to the rise of Israel's greatest king. It's a story about what happens when human ambition clashes with God's design, and what it truly means to have a "heart after God."

❖ **Chapel: The Gospel of Matthew (David Schmitt)**

"And you shall call His Name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

The Prophets Foretold, Christ Fulfilled. That is the message of the first book of the New Testament, the gospel of Matthew. Within the pages of this incredible book is an account of the things Jesus taught and did to fulfill the pages of the Old Testament Scriptures. We will explore the importance this book has for the Jewish reader as we look at the first half of Matthew. We will uncover the things they would look for to identify the prophesied Messiah, helping us also to understand who the Messiah is, and what He has done for us. From the uniqueness of the genealogy, through the teachings of the Sermon on the Mount, and Jesus' interactions with the people around Him, we will gain a grand perspective of Jesus Christ through the lens of the Old Testament Scriptures.

❖ **Young Adults "Count it All Joy" (Ivan Gonzalez)**

How can we experience joy in difficult circumstances? This class will study Count It All Joy, based on Paul's letter to the Philippians, written while he was imprisoned. Together, we will discover how true joy is found not in our circumstances, but in Christ, and how we can live with confidence, faith, and purpose no matter what we face.

❖ **Spanish Class W/ Various Teachers | Clase en Español | Room 201**


