EDITORIAL

Ministry & Maintenance Report 2022

1. You gave \$713,291.73 in regular weekly contributions PLUS \$24,440.38 in special collections on months with five Sundays, for a grand total of \$737,732.11, averaging \$14,187.16 per week.
2. Eight precious souls were baptized into Jesus Christ.
3. Thirty-four new people placed membership with us.
4. Eleven of our members went to be with Jesus, which is where we all hope to be one day!
5. We enjoyed a wide variety of ministries serving at full capacity such as: Community Cupboard, Football Team Meals, DCYG, Easter in the Park, VBS, Camp Rock Creek, Day Camp, Whiz Kids, Fall Festival, Ladies Bible Study, Women's Conference, Community Cup, Wednesday Night Meals, Mission Sunday, 70th Anniversary Celebration, Meals on Wheels, Community Garden, Visitation, Summer Nights of Service, Community Cookouts.
6. Community Cupboard served a total of 594 families consisting of 580 adults and 418 children, averaging right at 50 families per month (83 people per month).
7. Meals on Wheels served at least 11,250 meals to the community.
8. We fed around 50 hungry football players and coaches before every Del City High School home game, forming solid relationships with the players.
9. The Christmas Store ministry served 36 families and 116 children.
10. Summer Nights of Service did yard work, fed homeless, aided the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma, visited newcomers to the community, made blankets.
11. We added a Communications Director to our staff to streamline our congregational communications and social media presence.
12. We supported 19 different Mission Works.
13. We supported Children's homes with \$17,600.00.
14. We made repairs and updates to the campus including overhauling the parking lot.
