Praising God in Prayer

Talking to God

Praise God for making you and everything you have, including food, a home and people who love you.

Diving In

Think about the things you're grateful for. Make a list of 10 of them. Tell someone why you're grateful for each, and praise God for all that He has given you.

Going Deeper

Through the use of short blessing prayers that relate to everyday life, people learn to praise God and express thanksgiving. The moment you open your eyes in the morning, you might pray, "Thank You, God, for my eyes. Thank You for sight." While getting dressed, you could pray, "Thank You, God, for meeting my needs—giving me clothes to wear, such as these," and at the first sight of the sun, you may declare, "God, You are so great! Thank You for your creation." Psalm 145:1-2 is a great example of how to praise God: "I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever." Praise God today and every day!

SERMON NOTES

Ma'on (Dwelling Place)

As a general rule, I'm pretty terrible with names. Being a preacher has made this particular shortcoming all the more obvious. To try to correct this, I have found that giving nicknames to people vastly improves my ability to remember them. Many times, I will call people anything but their real names. I call Ivan our "Ivan-gelist," Liz "Lizard," and Justin "J-Town." You get the idea. I've been given several nicknames in my life as well, ranging from the all-too-popular "Garebear" to the very rare "Girt-the-Dirt."

With people having multiple names they are called, it should come as no surprise that God has many names throughout the Bible as



well. Many of them are much more flattering than "Lizard," but interestingly, all God's names describe a different aspect of His character. One of these is Ma'on, or "Dwelling Place." Moses, a nomad from the beginning and throughout his life, calls God his "Dwelling Place." We often make ourselves at home in a world that is temporary and transient, forgetting that we are most at home in the presence of God. What do we learn about God as our "Dwelling Place"?

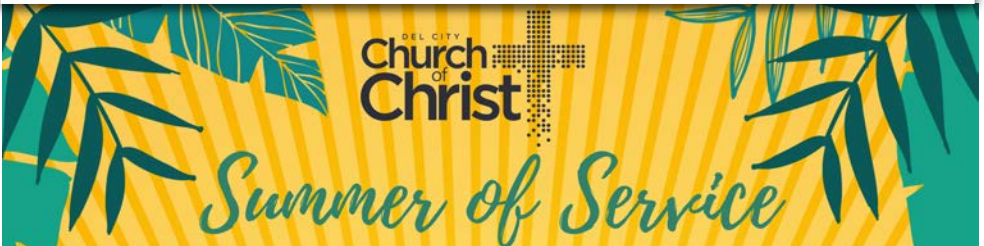
EN ESPAÑOL

Para tratar de corregir esto, he descubierto que dar apodos a las personas mejora enormemente mi capacidad para recordarlos. Muchas veces llamaré a la gente cualquier cosa que no sea sus nombres reales. Yo llamo a Ivan nuestro "Ivan-gelist", yo llamo a Liz, "Lizard", Justin, "J-Town", entiendes la idea. También me han dado varios apodos en mi vida, incluido el demasiado popular "Garebear" y el muy raro "Girt-the-Dirt".

Con las personas que tienen varios nombres a los que se les llama, no debería sorprender que Dios también tuviera muchos nombres en toda la Biblia. Muchos de ellos son mucho más halagadores que "Lagarto", pero curiosamente, todos los nombres de Dios describen un aspecto diferente de Su carácter. Uno de estos es Ma'on o "Lugar de residencia". Moisés, un nómada desde el principio y a lo largo de su vida, llama a Dios su "lugar de residencia". A menudo nos hacemos como en casa en un mundo que es temporal y transitorio, olvidando que estamos más en casa en la presencia de Dios. ¿Qué aprendemos sobre Dios como nuestro "lugar de residencia"?
