Invest or Spend?

"Should I invest or spend?" That is a question quite often asked in our world which revolves around money. When you get a raise, you have to decide whether to spend it or invest it. When a tax refund comes your way, will you spend it or invest it? The majority of the American people usually do much more spending than investing. If I could do the last forty years over again knowing then what I know today, I would have definitely done more investing.

attendance and fellowship get little if any attention. And when the year is ended, they have very little to show for the past twelve months.

But you can invest your year. And when you invest your year, you relish every day. But not the material things of the day. They, like time, are constantly diminishing. You relish the "Kodak Moments" of life that revolve around people and relationships. To invest time means you actively try to make a difference in someone's life by finding and serving their needs. Time investors or more patient than spenders. They can stop what they are doing and listen to the hurts or happiness of someone else. A time investor cannot pass by some beautiful part of God's creation without being reminded of His awesome power and wonderful care. Family time is guarded and cherished. A time investor takes the time to pray, not just a wishlist, but prayers of praise to God and petitions for the needs of others. He/she opens the Word of God with a sense of wonderment. Church attendance and fellowship are a high priority. For these are the things that last. These are the substance of a meaningful life. And when a life is lived like this, death is never premature. The time investor does not begrudge dying, for that is the time when the investment is about to pay off.

So be an investor instead of a spender in 2023.
