Thank You for Saving Lives

One unit of blood saves 3 lives. Red Blood Cells can be used for a patient, platelets can be used for a patient, and plasma can be used for a patient. That is how one unit can save 3 lives.

On mobile blood drives such as yours, we collect whole blood or what is referred to as a power red unit of blood. A unit is one donor. The power red means we take twice the amount of red blood cells as the machine separates the components during the donation.

Your recent blood drive resulted in 19 whole blood units which could save 57 lives. Thank you!
