EDITORIAL

This Is No Time To Wait

In Joshua 18, five years had gone by since Joshua and the Israelites had entered into the land of Canaan. Throughout the period of conquest they had often experienced the thrill of victory and sometimes the agony of defeat. God had been with them; He was their Captain and Commander. Finally, the land was theirs! "Now that the land was under Israelite control, the entire community of Israel gathered at Shiloh and set up the Tabernacle" (Joshua 18:1).

What a glorious time this must have been—a time to rejoice and relish the long awaited inheritance! But in verse 2, the Bible reads, "But there remained seven tribes who had not yet been allotted their grants of land." How could this be? The land was theirs! God had given it to them. There was nothing to stand in their way of possessing the land—except one thing: **PROCRASTINATION**. Then Joshua asked, "How long are you going to wait before taking possession of the remaining land the Lord, the God of your ancestors, has given to you?"

If you think procrastination is a problem unique to you or even the 21st century, think again. It is an age-old problem as old as the earth itself. Procrastination is the art of putting off until tomorrow those things that you should have done yesterday. And it is a thief that can

rob you of the victory you already have in Jesus Christ. The seven Israelite tribes had fought and overcome a lot. God had enabled them to live victoriously up to this point. But they were about to forfeit all of this by procrastinating.

God has already given you and me the victory over the world, but we must take possession of that victory. It is not enough to know you are the winner; you must possess your spoils. Procrastination is the art of putting off until tomorrow what you should have done yesterday. And it is a thief that can rob you of the victory you already have in Jesus Christ.

- Prayer is part of the spoils of life in Christ, yet we often put it off until later.
- Bible study enhances the victory, yet we put that off while we cruise social media or watch TV.
- Service brings tremendous joy and fulfillment, "But I'll get to it next week," we say.
- Christian fellowship is a great privilege, but when the opportunities for fellowship come, many will say, "I'll go next time."
- Teaching the lost has a bountiful reward, "But not yet; I am not ready."

How long will you keep putting off the important things of Christ? How long will you delay in entering to take possession of the land which the Lord has given you? This is no time to wait!
