The End Of The Matter

As we conclude our journey through Ecclesiastes, this week's sermon explores the poetic reflections on aging, the fleeting nature of life, and the call to remember our Creator while we still have strength. Though the Teacher ends with a familiar refrain—"Vanity of vanities"—the epilogue shifts our gaze beyond life "under the sun" to the One who sees all. Join us as we wrestle with wisdom that goads and guides, and discover how Ecclesiastes ultimately points us to Jesus—the healer of our brokenness and the hope beyond the breath.
