Monty Pettyjohn

We are excited to welcome Monty Pettyjohn, a former instructor at Sunset International Bible Institute (SIBI) and preacher at the Sunset Church of Christ for over 30 years, as he leads us through "The Journey: Walking as a Disciple" on Wednesday nights this

summer. Monty is an outstanding teacher with a deep passion for helping the church grow in discipleship.

Monty has been married to his wife, Diana, for 43 years, and together they have spent 33 of those years in full-time ministry. After graduating from SIBI in 1992, he served as the preacher for the church in Burlington, Colorado, for eight years. From 2000 to 2005, he worked as the Adult and Children's Education Minister at the Waterview Church of Christ in Richardson, Texas.



In 2005, Monty joined the staff at Sunset International Bible Institute in Lubbock, Texas, serving as the Director of Post-Graduation Internships. Two years later, in 2007, he also began teaching as an instructor at the institute. From 2010 to 2023, he served as the Lead Preaching Minister and Chief of Staff for the Sunset Church of Christ. During this time, he developed a particular focus on equipping believers to grow as disciples of Jesus.

That passion led Monty, in May 2023, to transition out of his ministry role at Sunset to launch a new para-church ministry called *The Journey*. Since August 2023, *The Journey* has been working alongside congregations, small groups, and individual Christians to support and strengthen their walk with Christ.
