## Great Faith in Unexpected Places

### **PART 1: The Centurion (Luke 7:1-10)**

#### **An Unexpected Man of Faith**

#### **Chapel: Matthew (Part 2)**

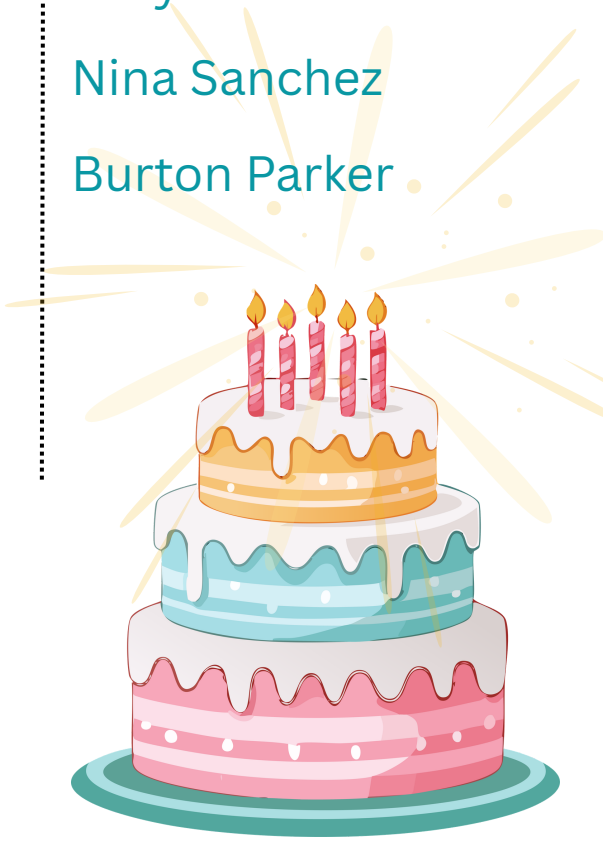
