Victorious Living: A Stirring Challenge Joshua 24:1-15

Joshua has faithfully led the Israelites to victorious possession of the Promised Land. As he prepares to die, he gathered all the people together for one last challenge found in Joshua 24:15, "Choose this day whom you will serve!" We want to close the Joshua series with that same challenge. Embedded within his challenge I see four challenges we need to accept if we hope to possess victorious living.

EDITORIAL

More Blessed

It was Jesus who said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35). That is true for a variety of reasons, but the one which stands out to me is it is in giving that we become most like God. He is the giver of all perfect and good gifts (James 1:17). He gives us all life. He gave Adam and Eve each other and the garden of Eden. He gave the Israelites the Promised Land and the Law to guide them. Then He gave them numerous chances to start over after they had failed. And He gave us Jesus Christ, who gives us all the chance to start over.

In becoming like God in giving, it also helps us to be able to worship Him in the right spirit; thus, it is a great tool in leading us into a meaningful worship relationship with God. Let me remind you of six vital qualities of Christian giving.

- Giving must be done **proportionately**. I am talking about ability. We need to be careful not to give beyond our ability to give on a regular basis, but we must also be sure we are giving up to our ability. Short-changing God simply short-changes the giver. Ability equals responsibility.
- Giving must be done sacrificially. God has always been impressed with those whose gift is a real sacrifice. Proportionate and sacrificial giving can augment one another. Simply make sure the gift costs you something and is not merely "chump change."

Short-changing God simply shortchanges the giver.

- ◆ Giving must be done **willingly**. God does not extract taxes from us like Uncle Sam. He gives us love and life, and the gift we give back comes from a willing heart out of an expression of appreciation. The Israelites were commanded to give 10%. That financed the nation, like a tax. But their freewill offerings had no minimums or limitations. They gave so much in the building of the tabernacle they had to be stopped. This is the result of willing giving. God does not require the gift as much as He requires the giver to want to give it.
- ◆ Giving must be done **cheerfully**. 2 Corinthians 9:7 is the classic text. Willingly and cheerfully do not necessarily go hand in hand. But they should. Give what you give and be excited about it. Don't wish for it back; rather, wish it could have been more.
- ◆ Giving must be done **regularly**. The Corinthians were told to give every first day of the week (1 Corinthians 16:2). There is wisdom in this for us. 1) We are constantly reminded of where our wealth comes from; 2) It can remind us of the sacrifice of Christ as we regularly sacrifice; 3) It gives us a sense of ownership in the local church. For where your treasure is...
- Giving must be done purposely. In giving, we must have a specific purpose. Giving to create a wealthy bank account is senseless.
 Giving to carry on specific works of Jesus is biblical. Focus on our ministries to make giving have a purpose.
