How Justice Points to God

Before I became a minister full time, I was an attorney. In that regard, I've always felt a kinship with the Apostle Matthew, being trained in a profession that most view as a pack of liars and cheats, and still being called by Jesus anyway! Along those lines, I've always been fascinated with the concept of justice, and why humans value it so highly. In fact, it seems many in the world, regardless of spirituality, want justice to be done in our world. However, this stance has also confused me in some regards. For instance,

In Richard Dawkins book, "The God Delusion," he states;

"Molecules that would normally make nothing more complicated than chunks of rock, gather themselves together into chunks of rock-sized matter of such staggering complexity that they are capable of running, jumping, swimming, flying, seeing, hearing, capturing and eating other such animated chunks of complexity; capable in some cases of thinking and feeling, and falling in love with yet other chunks of complex matter. We now understand essentially how this trick is done, but only since 1859 (the publication of Darwin's Origin of Species).

According to Mr. Dawkins, who is a loud proponent of atheism, humans are nothing more than molecules that happened to get lucky, and create a complex organism. To him, you may think yourself a person with inherent worth; but in reality, you are no better than the chair you sit on, you are just a bit more complicated. If true, this point of view would have some pretty horrific consequences in terms of humanity's sense of justice. If I am just a by-product of random chance, my molecules rolling around the Earth with no point but to make life as advantageous to myself as possible, why should I value anyone else? Why should I value even myself?

We are made in God's image, (Genesis 1:27) and because of that, are instilled with a sense of justice that cannot be explained by evolution alone. If I am just the sum of my biology, why do I care when my fellow man is mistreated? As long as it's not me, why should I really do anything to stop it? For that matter, as long as it gains me an advantage, what is holding me back from mistreating everyone I can? The answer: Our sense of justice. God put within us a higher calling that separates us from all else in creation. Our capacity to love our fellow man, and our want for our world to be just, all comes from the Father. This very sense of fairness points us not just to an existence of a god, but THE God.
