Wednesday Night Activities!

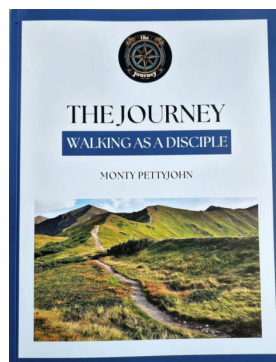
