## **Credibility of an Eyewitness**

We live in the age of relativism, which is borderline deceit. The mainstream media machine spins every story or event that may be of interest to an unsuspecting John Q. Public for maximum clicks and views and astonishment. Absolute facts seem to rarely matter to them. What will create the most outrage? What will create the most buzz? How can I attract the most viewers/readers? Those seem to be the driving-force questions. So speculation becomes the source. Hearsay becomes the howitzer that jettison's the storyline into the wild. Conjecture becomes the concrete that makes a story stick. Whatever happened to good old fashioned journalism where you found an eyewitness or two whose stories collaborated each other? Anybody else miss Walter Cronkite?

Anyway, one of the things I love about the Scriptures is that there is no relativism. The Scriptures are clear and concise, absolute and abundant in testimony. And when it comes to Jesus Christ, the Word is chock full of eyewitness testimonies and accounts of His life and ministry. Today, as we begin a new series called *Eyewitness Good News*, we are going to be relying on the credible eyewitness testimony of John the apostle as recorded in the letter of 1 John.

John was one of the first disciples Jesus called to leave his current occupation and follow Jesus. John immediately left his father and

occupation and followed Jesus intensely for the rest of his natural life. Of the twelve disciples who later became known as the apostles, he was one of the three who were closest to Jesus (Peter, James and John). He got to see things in the life of Christ seen only by himself along with Peter and James. And of all the apostles, John alone held the distinction of being the "disciple that Jesus loved," indicating they had a special closeness. You might even be able to conclude that

John was Jesus' best friend on earth. When all the other disciples forsook Him and fled the night of His betrayal, John followed Him into the inner courts to witness all of the abuse that night. At the crucifixion, John was at the foot of the cross with the women who were also there, and Jesus gave him charge of His own mother, Mary.

John authored the Gospel of John, 1, 2 & 3 John and Revelation. As far as we know, he lived the longest of any of the other apostles, and died at a very old age while in exile on the Island of Patmos, somewhere off the coast of present-day Turkey.

As an eyewitness of the life and ministry of Christ, I find him to be extremely credible. In his own words he states: "We proclaim to you the One who existed from the beginning, Whom we have **heard** and **seen**. We **saw** Him with **our own eyes** and touched Him with our own hands. He is the Word of life. This One Who is life itself was revealed to us, and **we have seen Him**. And now we testify and proclaim to you that He is the One that is eternal life...We proclaim to you what we ourselves **have actually seen** and heard" (1 John 1:1-3).
