EDITORIAL

Guidelines for Studying Any Bible Book

- **I. Historical Context** Helps you understand the life and times of the people who first read the work.
 - A. Historical information on a particular city where the recipients lived helps put you in their setting, so you can better understand their culture.
 - B. Historical information on the church defines its roots (i.e., do we have a record of when the church began?), strengths and weaknesses, aiding in a basic understanding of the overall context.
- II. Multiple Readings It is important to read the book, particularly the epistles (or letters), several times through. This will aid you in understanding the immediate context.
 - A. Read the epistles as a letter, for that is what they are.
 - B. Each time you read, focus on a different question for which you are seeking an answer. For example: Who is the author? What does this writing tell me about him? Who were the recipients? What does this writing tell me about them? What was the place of writing? What appears to be the occasion and purpose of this writing? Does it have a theme and what is it? What does it tell me about the nature of God? Jesus? Holy Spirit? What does it teach about daily Christian living?
 - C. Read from more than one reliable translation (preferably translated by a committee of people as opposed to just one person). Comparative readings can shed incredible light on the text even though you may not have a working knowledge of the original languages.
 - D. Keep a dictionary and a concordance handy, to define unfamiliar terms and find related texts, respectively.
 - E. Always read with a pen/pencil and plenty of paper for note-taking.
- III. Consult Commentaries This should be done only after you have a good working knowledge of the book you are studying.
 Consulting a commentary too early in the study may color or prejudice your understanding of the book. Remember: the Bible is inspired commentaries are not.

Keep this this as a reference guide to assist you in your own daily Bible study life.

God wants us to live as victors, not victims; to defeat evil rather than be defeated. But victory is not ours by strength, determination, cunning or personal ingenuity. 
