#### **EDITORIAL**

#### Good News! Jesus Can...

Most of us enjoy telling others good news. We love to share with others the things that make us happy, such as a new job, car, or engagement. We ask others to join in our celebration of marriage or having children. We love to tell others good news. While most Christians grasp the profound significance of Jesus' sacrifice for our salvation and his resurrection promising eternal life with Him, we often neglect to share the 'greatest news we've ever heard' with others.

Has anyone ever given you a gift? When you were given this gift, did it make you mad? Did it cause you to think unkind things about



the person giving you the gift? When we start to think about the Gospel as a gift that we want to give others, how can they be mad at us? They may disagree with us. They may not enjoy the gift (much like we don't always like the gift

offered to us), but there is no reason for people to respond with hostility to an offered gift. But there is some wisdom in our giving God's gift of salvation.

- 1. Don't get so Caught Up in Winning an Argument. Too often, we want to start arguments over issues, including the proper way to worship God, with or without instruments, how often we should take communion? and whether we should sing new or old songs. The truth is that while all of these subjects are important, we do wrong when we debate these topics rather than allowing God to speak to us through His Word. We need to stop telling others why they are wrong in their thinking and just tell others about Jesus. Once we do that, Jesus can then speak on those subjects.
- 2. Stop Worrying about how others will think of us and worry more about what others might think of Jesus. One of the reasons people refrain from speaking is because they get too nervous. Yet we will go to a job interview while we're nervous. Even if we're nervous, we will climb aboard a plane to take us to our vacation destination. We usually don't let our nerves convince us to stop things we want to do. We must stop using this as an excuse since God commanded us to go.
- 3. Quit worrying about what we can't do and focus only on what Jesus can do. We often quote *Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me,*" and say we believe it. But do we believe this statement for ourselves? If we do, then Jesus can give me the strength to tell others about God's gift of salvation. Jesus can give us the words to say as we learn to communicate God's Word so that He speaks more than us. Jesus can do incredible things through those willing to be involved in His Work. Do you believe that Jesus can?
