How an 8 Year-Old Sees God

A church newsletter included this essay by Danny Dutton, age 8. His Sunday School teacher had asked her students to explain God.

God sees everything and hears everything and is everywhere. Which keeps Him pretty busy. So you shouldn't go wasting His time asking for things that aren't very important, or go over your parents' heads and ask for something they said vou couldn't have."

What an interesting perspective about God! I thought it was pretty cute and astute. Though a bit misguided, there are some elements worth highlighting:

- God does make all people. He is involved with every single one.
- No nobler role could anyone have than to be a parent given the task of assisting God in the training of one of these little ones fashioned by the hands of the Almighty.
- God does listen to our prayers, but He never grows weary or deafened. We serve a loving Father who is interested in the affairs of His children.
- Because God sees everything, hears everything, and is everywhere we should be especially mindful of what we do, what we say and where we go.
- Because God has made every person with whom you come in contact, treat each one as special creations. Don't forget that people are more important than plans, projects or possessions.
