# **Three R's of Progress**

I am told that school curriculum has gotten increasingly complex over the years. Perhaps this is in proportion with the increased complexity of the world in which we live. However, in the early days of American schooling, the curriculum had three R's: Reading, 'Riting and 'Rithmatic.

Our "life curriculum" has also gotten increasingly complex. Bad news travels faster than ever. And stress has become a major crippler in society. This has leaked over into the church as well. 2023 is now half over and I think now is a good time to remind ourselves of what I call the *Three R's of Progress*. Did you make any resolutions for 2023? Perhaps you have let some of those wonderful resolutions slip by the wayside. So let's contemplate how to get back on track on the road to progress.

**Reflect**. Though it is true we should not spend too much time dwelling on the past, there is an appropriate time to reflect. Too much reflection can cause us to become lazy and unproductive, possibly with discouragement over failures. But not enough reflection can prevent us from seeing how we are doing. Are we sticking with those goals and resolutions we set for ourselves with such wide-eyed hope just a few

months ago? Have you made adequate progress toward changing those bad habits? Are you spending daily time in the Word like you told God you wanted to do? Are you really spending more quality and memorable time with your family? Reflect so you will know where you are.

**Refocus**. Once you have reflected, you must refocus on your goals and life's direction. Where is your target? Refocus your scope so you will not be

in danger of missing your target. As a church our focus must be to seek and save the lost while keeping the saved saved. But distractions come and we can lose focus if we are not intentional. Focus is necessary to grow a great church. Remember: a greater church begins with me; it begins with you. It takes individual effort to refocus the whole. One member out of focus changes the focus of the whole group. Dive into the Word of God and pray for Him to sharpen your spiritual focus, then surround yourself with others who are doing the same.

**Renew**. As long as there is breath in your body and desire in your heart, it is never too late to renew, recommit, to resolve to do better. There are six months left of 2023. Renew your commitment to the Lord Jesus, to His church, to becoming like Him in every way. Pray for renewed strength and passion to carry out the mission and ministry of Christ in your life. Make sure that when Jesus comes back He will have no trouble knowing that you are one of His.
