EDITORIAL

How to Win Over Satan

What motivates you to stay out of sin? Sin is a slippery slope spread with fresh grease by the devil himself. He wants to defeat you. How can we win against those odds? The apostle John encourages us to "remain in fellowship with Christ so that when He returns, you will be full of courage and not shrink back from Him in shame" (1 John 2:28). He goes on to remind us that Christ is righteous and when we do right we are God's children (1 John 2:29). Then in chapter 3:1-10, he tells us that the way to win over Satan is to remember. He gives us three key points to remember which will help us win over Satan.

Remember your parent (1 John 2:28-3:1). We must remember that our heavenly parent is God Almighty. Don't forget whose kid you are! God is not some tyrant hiding behind a tree hoping you will fail so He can retaliate. He is a loving parent who just wants His children to be like Him. God is righteous, therefore His desire is for His children to also be righteous. A son tries to imitate his dad. A daughter will want to be like her mother. Children innocently watch our every move so they can imitate. There were many times in my life I made right choices, not because I was good, but because I didn't want to disappoint my parents. God expects us to do the same. We must never forget that we are His children, therefore we will act accordingly, lest we let Him down.

Remember your purpose (1 John 3:2-6). In these verses, John reminds us that one of our chief purposes as children of God is to be pure, just like God is. You might say it is our family tradition. Family traditions are important. They keep you grounded. They can be a source of fond memories that warm your heart in your lonely moments. In the family of God, our family tradition is to be pure, to abstain from sin as much as we can. We can do this by imitating God and Christ, assembling regularly with other church family members to receive reminders of this purpose, as well as to encourage one another in our daily walk with the Lord, looking up to those who may be a little stronger than we are. Little eight-year-olds go out and hit home runs when they are not usually home run hitters because they have been watching their big brothers or sisters. We are better together.

Remember your practice (1 John 3:7-10). There is a huge difference between the practice of the children of God versus the children of the devil. In these four verses, John gives an easy definition between right and wrong. Our practice is to avoid sin. If we fail in that, then our practice is to repent and NOT to keep on sinning. Once we know the wrong we did, we can choose not to do it again. "Those who have been born into God's family do not make a practice of sinning, because God's life is in them. So they can't keep on sinning, because they are children of God" (1 John 3:9). You may occasionally slip off of the straight and narrow path, but if you will remember that is not your normal practice, it will help you get back up onto the right path again.

Remember your parent. Remember your purpose. Remember your practice. This will help you win over Satan's influence. And when you meet Jesus face to face, you can be confident and unashamed.

Eyewitness Good News: The Real McCoy 1 John 4:1-6

"The real McCoy" is a colloquial Americana phrase from the 1930s that means something is authentic and not bogus. How can you tell when you have "the real McCoy" religiously? So John reveals three actions we must take in order to discern "the real McCoy."
