## SERMON NOTES

### Growing a Great Church: Revival Revelation 2:1-7

One of the greatest needs of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century church is the need for revival. Churches across America have been in a free-fall since the year 2000, showing a net loss in membership. The Bible is replete with calls to revival. To grow a great church, we must be in a continual state of revival. Notice three aspects of revival in today's study.

## EDITORIAL

### The Servant and Conflict

One of life's axioms is, "Conflict will come." It is not a question of "if" or "will" but "when." When conflict arises, what do you do? Because we know it is coming, we can make plans of how to get the most out of it.

Conflict seems to arise between the most unlikely candidates in the most unlikely of circumstances. The hottest conflicts seem to arise in the home, between parents and children, or husband and wife. These are our most prized and valued relationships. This is where love is not only understood, but frequently spoken. This is the place where hugs and kisses, playing and praying, love and laughter should be normal occurrences. Immediate family members share the most intimacy of all humans; but they often also share the most intense conflicts of all.

The reason is not because of a lack of love. It is not because they cannot stand to be together. It is not because they each have hateful dispositions. It is because they do love each other. It is because they spend more time together than with any other people. It is because their love gives birth to great expectations... sometimes too great.

Conflict does not have to be bad. It is only bad when we react badly. A conflict is not the same as a fight or an argument. It is simply a point at which two people, two wills, differ and you notice the difference. Conflict can be a rewarding and enriching time for all parties concerned. Consider some positive aspects of conflict.

- Conflict means both people are thinking.** Parents raise their children to think for themselves and then get frustrated when they do. Thank God they are trying to use their minds.
- Conflict forces the issue of communication.** Some people think that communication is when two people agree, or when I have said my peace and you have listened. Not necessarily. Communication is the exchanging of ideas, with both parties understanding what is on the inside of the other. Sometimes conflict forces real communication to happen. It is a kind of wake up call for both parties to start listening.
- Conflict may testify to true love.** Think about it! If I did not love you, it would not be worth the effort and energy to hammer out our conflict. The fact that I am sticking with you through the conflict is a telltale sign that I think you are significant.
- Conflict opens the door to be a servant.** To resolve a conflict will mean that someone will have to become a servant. Someone will have to put the other's interests first. When conflict comes, pray that God will make you a servant.
