## Keep Your Line In The Water!

I read the following story a few years ago. One Saturday, Eric Fellman arrived at a lake for a day of fishing with his young sons, Jason and Jon. Everyone agreed to let the boat drift with the breeze that morning and fish a shoal near the landing. As usual, Eric spent the first thirty minutes rigging their lines, baiting the hooks, and positioning the boat.

"By the time I started to fish," Eric said, "Jon had put down his pole and started munching on donuts and playing in the water. Rather than taking time to rig my own pole, I picked up his and began casting."

"Time passed when, suddenly, I had a strike. It was the biggest small-mouth bass I'd ever hooked! With much yelling and scrambling, we somehow managed to net the prize a few minutes later. When we all calmed down, we measured it to be twenty-one inches and five pounds, four ounces."

"Jon blurted out, 'Dad, how come you catch all the fish?"

"'Well, Jon,' I replied, 'I guess because I keep my line in the water. You can't catch fish eating donuts.'"

When I read that story I thought, "That is exactly on target!" The biggest key to success or victory in the pursuit of any dream is keeping your line in the water. Don't give up too soon!

Has your marriage been rocky lately? Don't pull in your line and head for shore. Stay with it. Work at it. Keep casting. Does your job feel like a dead end? Don't quit working at it. Work even harder. Be an "extra-miler" and leave your line in. Maybe you need to change your bait (attitude) and not your location (job). Opportunities to grow will come if you don't give up too soon. Perhaps you have family pressures. Or joblessness. Or an illness that won't quit. The easy way is to eat donuts and distract yourself with water play. But that won't catch any fish!

When you feel like laying down your line, think about Jesus. Don't you think He felt like quitting occasionally? When the people pressed and the Pharisees preyed, when the sick kept coming and sinners came running, when the betrayer kissed Him and the cross burdened Him I know He had to feel like pulling in His line. But He didn't. He persevered. And you can, too. "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus..." (Hebrews 12:1-2).
