SERMON NOTES

Christian Authenticity

Have you ever pondered what it may be like to live in a make-believe, fantasy world? No pain would be suffered, no illness endured, and we'd never have to say goodbye to loved ones because of death. No children would be abused, no marriage would be aborted, no jobs would be lost. You would be able to eat everything without gaining anything. You could stay physically fit without getting physically fatigued. And everyone would live happily ever after.

But we don't live in such a world. The responsibilities of life are often heavy—and sometimes harsh. The sorrows and disappointments we frequently face expand to mountain-sized loads to carry. Pain, suffering, illness and premature goodbyes are all too real. "Happiness ever after" is often replaced with "grin-and-bear-it."

Since that is true, we must make sure that what we offer to others as a remedy to everyday life (which is Jesus Christ and life as His disciple) is real and not counterfeit. Life is too serious to squander it on plastic religion which breaks under the slightest pressure. We need to look for, demand and expect authenticity in Christianity. And in 1 John 3:10-13, John reveals three characteristics of the authentic Christian. "10 So now we can tell who are children of God and who are children of the devil. Anyone who does not live righteously and does not love other believers does not belong to God. If This is the message you have heard from the beginning: We should love one another. If We must not be like Cain, who belonged to the evil one and killed his brother. And why did he kill him? Because Cain had been doing what was evil, and his brother had been doing what was righteous. If So don't be surprised, dear brothers and sisters, if the world hates you."

Authenticity is evident by your *reflection* **of God** (verse 10). The Christian should be a little replica of God. If you don't look like God, you are not His child; you are a child of the devil. Do you remind others of God? When they see your life, do they conclude you must be a child of God?

Authenticity is evident by your *regard* **for your brethren** (verses 10-13). If you don't love *any* other Christian, you are not authentic. Love for God ties one to all of God's children in family warmth and togetherness. To do otherwise is to be like Cain who belonged to the evil one and killed his brother. Love is the bedrock of Christian living. Jesus brought a new life, molded and motivated by love. A Christian without love is like a new automobile without an engine: it may be pretty to look at, but it is useless. This love John is talking about is a decision to do whatever it takes for the good of others. It will motivate us to fight for the recovery of fallen brothers or sisters. Authentic Christians are in the rescue and recovery business.

Authenticity is evident by your relationship with the world (verses 12-13). Authentic Christians should be different from the world. The difference inspires some and irritates others, like Cain was irritated by Abel. A.W. Tozer once said, "To be right with God has often meant trouble with men." Prepare for persecution. Pray for those around you to have receptive hearts to the way of Christ. Arm yourself through regular prayer and Bible study to be able to resist having your righteousness adversely affected by the wickedness around you. Resolve to persevere in your life for God in spite of the world.

Eyewitness Good News: What's Love Got To Do With It? 1 John 4:7-21

If you have ever had your heart broken, it's easy to be cynical about love. That is, if you understand love to only be an emotion. But genuine love is a selfless decision. Some grow weary hearing sermons about love. But to do so is to grow weary of God Himself, for God is love. What's love got to do with it? Just everything. Without love there is no God, no Christianity, no salvation and no church. John discusses three aspects of love we must understand in order to understand God.
