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### **Four-Way Stops**

I suppose everyone has at least one "pet-peeve." One of mine is the awkward dilemma frequently experienced at four-way stop signs. I have recently been reminded of this with the four-way stop signs located at SE 15th Street and Vickie Drive (I will be so glad when the traffic light is working!). No one seems to know when to stop or go. Invariably you will get into an "after you" contest. Then in desperation, you both start going at the same time! There doesn't seem to be any way to solve the dilemma and remove the awkwardness.

But there is! It is usually taught when one takes *Driver's Education*. At the very least, you can find the solution in the *Driver's Handbook*, which everyone must study prior to taking the *Driver's License Test*. The instructions are very clear. When approaching an intersection with a four-way stop, the first one there has the right-of-way. If you both get there at the same time, the driver to the right has the right-of-way. That is soooooo simple. Why, then, has it become complicated? Apparently some of the people don't know the rule book.

Think about it! Isn't that the way life in general has become? So many times we don't know how to proceed, and we wander around in the valley of indecision. Or we make the wrong decisions about life, sin,

religion, etc. Life really does get awkward. Sometimes so much so that we end up in the "intersection" at the wrong time and have a collision, either with a significant relationship, with ourselves or with God. But life doesn't have to be that way! God has given us a "Driver's Handbook," so to speak. The instructions are clear. Jesus tells us that He is "the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:6). His Word is the

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handbook. "For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart" (Hebrews 4:12). We don't have to sit around at life's intersections and wonder whether we should stop or go. The Bible is not that complicated. We just need to commit to doing what it says, then do it.

I have no doubt that the awkward drivers at the four-way stops in our community at one time knew the rule for these intersections. Why don't they still know it? Perhaps they are afraid the next guy doesn't know and follow the same rule. Or perhaps they have forgotten it. Think about it! How many times have you studied the *Driver's Handbook* since you took your first *Driver's License Test*? I must admit it is not my regular reading choice. We need constant reminders, because human nature is forgetful.

The same is even more true with the Bible. God's little instruction book cannot just be read once and the reader hope to retain everything. We need constant reminding to successfully maneuver life's awkward intersections. May I encourage you to regularly refresh your mind with God's Word? It will make "four-way stops" a breeze.

## **SERMON NOTES**

### Growing a Great Church: Keeping the Saved Saved 1 Corinthians 3:5-11

If we are going to grow a great church, we must keep the saved saved. How do you keep folks in Jesus once you catch them for Jesus? In today's text, the apostle Paul likens building disciples to building a house. Just as there are three main stages to building a house (the foundation, the framing and the finish work), there are also three stages to building disciples. It is important that we complete each stage *in the right order* if we hope to defeat the Christian dropout syndrome. Notice three stages for building sturdy disciples of Christ.

### I. Build the Right F\_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 3:11).

- A. We must build the foundation of J\_\_\_\_\_ C\_\_\_\_ in the hearts of all prospective believers.
- B. A lot of people talk about T\_\_\_\_\_, but Jesus was T\_\_\_\_\_ talking.
- C. We must quit trying to make M\_\_\_\_\_ of the church and start making D\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus.
- D. To C\_\_\_\_\_ the F\_\_\_\_\_ is foolish.
- E. Spend more time studying the L\_\_\_\_ and C\_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus than the fundamentals of church, initially.

#### II. Build the Right F\_\_\_\_\_ (1 John 1:3).

- A. The word *fellowship* simply means a joint P\_\_\_\_\_ in a C\_\_\_\_\_ venture.
- B. Four areas of fellowship we must develop:
  - C\_\_\_\_\_\_ the church should be a H\_\_\_\_\_ of R\_\_\_\_\_ where brothers and sisters protect one another.

- 4. C\_\_\_\_\_\_ this word in 2 Corinthians 9:13 is the exact same word translated as *fellowship* everywhere else.

#### III. Build the Right F\_\_\_\_\_ (Jude 3).

- A. We must *last of all* B\_\_\_\_\_ the right B\_\_\_\_\_ of faith.
- B. The Lord said they will know we are His D\_\_\_\_\_ by our love, not by our D\_\_\_\_\_.
- C. When what we teach a new believer is A\_\_\_\_\_, we are going to develop an A\_\_\_\_\_ disciple.
- D. Begin by building a faith dedicated to C\_\_\_\_\_ trust in and obedience to C\_\_\_\_\_ and His Word.
