EDITORIAL

Some Folks Grumble

Some folks grumble and complain. They never smile, they never sing. They just don't walk on the narrow way, And they won't go to Heaven on the Judgment Day.

Those are the lyrics to a song we used to sing at camp and VBS when I was young. I mentioned it in my class last Sunday morning as we were working our way through Philippians 2.

When I think about grumbling, I often think about the Israelites. I don't mean to be unkind, but those Israelites escape my understanding. To start with, after the Golden Calf escapade (see Exodus 32), the only reason they were all still alive was because Moses interceded on their behalf. Aaron conjured up the wildest lie I have ever heard. Yet he was still allowed to serve as High Priest. God's grace and mercy are amazing!

In spite of those happenings, Miriam and Aaron later murmured against Moses as God's leader in Numbers 12. God rebukes them and

causes Miriam to be a leper for 7 days. When the pessimistic report came back after the 12 spies had spied out the land, the people began to grumble and prone to grumble and wish that they had never left Egypt (Numbers 14). God wanted to wipe them out again, but is again stayed by the intercession of Moses.

As long as we are apt and gripe, we will be miserable and God will not bless us.

Is there no gratitude among these people? In Number 16, Korah, Dathan and Abiram rose up against Moses and grumbled against him, questioning his leadership. They were all destroyed by the Lord. Did that put the fear of the Lord in this stiff-necked people? Only for a moment. For in Numbers 20, when water was scarce, the people began to grumble and complain. On other occasions, God provided for all their needs including water. But they had spiritual amnesia and their grumbling prompted even Moses to disobey the Lord and strike the rock instead of only speaking to it. How exasperating!

You know, that is always the end result of grumbling. It will always displease the Lord and exasperate even the best of His servants. I suppose that is why Paul told the Philippian church, and thus all disciples, "Do all things without grumbling or questioning" (Philippians

Grumble, grumble, grumble. That is what some folks do best. I pray that you are not like that. God wants us to enjoy life and be blessed by Him. But as long as we are apt and prone to grumble and gripe, we will be miserable and He will not bless. It can cause the best of us to act like the worst of us. Let us all commit to being positive and supportive of one another.
