EDITORIAL

Here at Del City, we want to promote good Biblical discussion not only in the building but also in the homes of our members. This devotional is provided so that perhaps, sometime this coming week, your family can dedicate time to gathering together and studying God's Word.

Devotional

Think about the past 24 hours. What did you spend time talking about? Perhaps you talked about things you must do, what happened during your day, your favorite sports team, TV show, that new podcast you listened to, a book you read, and so on.

In 2007, researchers at the University of Arizona found that, on average, men and women speak roughly 16,000 words daily. I would never have guessed that I use that many words daily, and I talk A LOT.

Now, looking back on my words, how many of those were well thought out? How many of those were used to lift or tear down? How many of those were complaints or words of thankfulness? How many of those were about my faith?

God cares about the words we use. James 3 Says, "All kinds of animals, birds, reptiles and sea creatures are being tamed and have been tamed by mankind, 8 but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison.

9 With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse human beings, who have been made in God's likeness. 10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this should not be."

This passage emphasizes the good and evil our words can do and how powerful they can be. How much attention do we pay to what comes out of our mouths? Are we intentional with what we say so that others can be lifted up? Are we making sure that we are speaking up about our faith? This week, let's encourage one another to be more thoughtful with our words and practice being people who put those 16,000 words to good use.
