EDITORIAL

Happy Peacemakers

The greatest preacher who ever preached began the greatest sermon every delivered by telling folks how to find happiness. The pursuit of happiness is core to the American dream. It was also the dream of the first-century Jews.

So the Master shares the keys of happiness (Matthew 5). Poorness of spirit. Godly mourning. Meekness. Insatiable appetite for right. Mercifulness. Purity of heart. Maker of peace. Persecuted for rightness. Insulted for Christ. That is hardly the list compiled by the god of this world, but what does he know about happiness?! The Creator knows how His creation can be happy. Truly happy. All of these keys are important and necessary as we grow in Christ. Volumes could be written about each, but the scope of this article will simply focus on one: "Blessed [a holy way of saying happy] are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God" (Matthew 5:8). I like the way Simple English Bible reads: "People who make peace will be happy, because they will be called sons of God." Have you ever wondered why there are not more happy Christians? Perhaps it is because there are not more makers and keepers of peace.

We need men and women who will pursue true happiness by being peacemakers. The reason Jesus said peacemakers will become sons of God is because His primary mission as the Son of God on Earth was to be a peacemaker between God and us. For me to be a peacemaker means I take on one of the primary characteristics of Christ-likeness.

From humanity's first brush with the devil, there was a dividing barrier between us and our God. It is called sin. "Your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you" (Isaiah 59:2). We were God's enemies! Jesus came to change all that by bringing peace. "Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1). Read that again. Because of Jesus we now have peace with God! "At just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly...When we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son" (Romans 5: 6, 10). This is why Jesus came, to restore peace to our relationship with God. "He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near" (Ephesians 2:17).

Think of your own sins before God. What all have YOU done to push Him away? What have YOU said that offended Him? Yet YOU have peace with Him because of the Prince of Peace. If we can live at peace with God with all of our faults, shouldn't we be able to live at peace with one another?

I believe we can. But YOU are going to have to be a peacemaker. It will take work. Selflessness. Laying down your life for the sake of another. Killing your pride, plans and preconceived ideas. That's the way Jesus did it. And it hurt. But the end result was worth it to Him. At times, being a peacemaker will will hurt you, too. But it will be so worth it! You will be truly happy. You will be called a prince (or princess) of peace. You will be called a son (or daughter) of God. Be a happy peacemaker! "If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone" (Romans 12:18).
