- ❖ The Truth of Today:
  - You must SEEK God's KINGDOM first.
- What is God's Kingdom?
  - ANYWHERE God rules.

"The time for judging this world has come, when Satan, the ruler of this world, will be cast out."

John 12:31 (NLT)

You used to live in sin, just like the rest of the world, obeying the devil – the commander of the powers in the unseen world. He is the spirit at work in the hearts of those who refuse to obey God.

Ephesians 2:2 (NLT)

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think.

### 2. Love.

And as we live in God, our love grows more perfect. So we will not be afraid on the day of judgment, but we can face him with confidence because we live like Jesus here in this world. <sup>18</sup>Such love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear. If we are afraid, it is for fear of punishment, and this shows that we have not fully experienced his perfect love.

### ❖ How to Surrender it All to God:

## 1. Love <u>GOD</u> more than you love the <u>WORLD</u>.

Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ <sup>9</sup>and become one with him. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith. <sup>10</sup>I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead.

#### 2. You must avoid ENTANGLEMENTS.

And when people escape from the wickedness of the world by knowing our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and then get tangled up and enslaved by sin again, they are worse off than before.

## 3. Know your <u>BODY</u> is a part of God's Kingdom.

Then the word of the Lord came to me saying, <sup>6</sup>"Can I not, O house of Israel, deal with you as this potter does?" declares the Lord. "Behold, like the clay in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, O house of Israel."

## 4. You must be <u>WILLING</u> to surrender it all.

And so, dear brother and sisters, I pled with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice – the kind he will find acceptable.
