## The Truth of Today:

- God speaks daily in **DIFFERENT** ways.
- You Must Know: God is <u>NOT OBLIGATED</u> to stop you from making a mistake!

## How Does God Speak?

1. God speaks through the BIBLE.

Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.

Psalm 119:105 (NLT)

But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means.

1 Corinthians 2:14 (NLT)

And then he added, "It is what comes from inside that defiles you. <sup>21</sup>For from within, out of a person's heart, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, <sup>22</sup>adultery, greed, wickedness, deceit, lustful desires, envy, slander, pride, and foolishness. <sup>23</sup>All these vile things come from within; they are what defile you."

Such things were written in the Scriptures long ago to teach us. And the Scriptures give us hope and encouragement as we wait patiently for God's promises to be fulfilled.

2. God speaks through PRAYER.

And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. <sup>27</sup>And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will.

And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us.

"You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father."

- The Purpose of Prayer is: To adjust <u>ME</u> to God, not to adjust <u>GOD</u> to me.
- 3. God speaks through **CIRCUMSTANCES**.

4. God speaks through the CHURCH.
