

RESPONDING TO GOOD NEWS OF GREAT JOY

Luke 2:8-14 ESV

1. Great FEAR is humanity's NATURAL response to the glory of God.

2. Great JOY is humanity's GRACIOUS response to the glory of God.

And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. ¹² And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger."

Luke 2:10-12 (ESV)

But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. ⁶ And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" ⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

3. Great WORSHIP is how we give God the glory and honor He deserves.
