GO AND DO

And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. ¹⁷And the scroll of Isaiah the prophet was handed to Him. And He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written: ¹⁸"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He anointed Me to bring good news to the poor.
