The Truth of Today:

 You must have a <u>SPIRITUAL PATTERN</u>. Hold on to the <u>pattern</u> of wholesome teaching you learned from me—a <u>pattern</u> shaped by the <u>faith</u> and <u>love</u> that you have in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:13 (NLT)

Your Pattern Must Include:

1. A daily GOD time.

"I have not departed from his commands but have treasured his words more than daily food."

Job 23:12 (NLT)

2. Having <u>FAITH</u> in God. For we live by faith, not by sight.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NIV)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Proverbs 3:5 (NLT)

3. Faith in the GOSPEL.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

John 3:16 (NIV)

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God.

Ephesians 2:8 (NLT)

4. Faith that <u>LEADS</u> to <u>ACTION</u>.

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. Hebrews 11:1 (NLT) Timothy, my dear son, be strong through the <u>grace</u> that God gives you in Christ Jesus. ²You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses...

5. Having faith that you have a <u>PURPOSE</u>.

But you, Timothy, certainly know what I teach, and how I live, and what my <u>purpose</u> in life is. You know my faith, my patience, my love, and my endurance.

6. <u>REMAINING</u> faithful.

But you must <u>remain faithful</u> to the things you have been taught. You know they are true, for you know you can trust those who taught you.
