- The Truth of Today:
  - To be <u>BLESSED</u> by God Be a <u>BLESSING</u>.
- ❖ To Be a Blessing:
  - 1. You must GO beyond your walls.

The Lord had said to Abram, "Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land that I will show you. <sup>2</sup>I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. <sup>3</sup>I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt. All the families on earth will be blessed through you."

## 2. You must STEP OUT in faith.

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. <sup>2</sup>This is what the ancients were commended for.

Hebrews 11:1-2 (NIV)

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going.

Hebrews 12:8 (NIV)

The real children of Abraham, then, are all those who put their faith in God.

Galatians 3:7 (NLT)

Genesis 22:18 (NLT)

"Live here as a foreigner in this land, and I will be with you and bless you. In this way, I have fully presented the Good News of Christ all the way from Jerusalem clear over into Illyricum. <sup>20</sup>My ambition has always been to preach the Good News where the name of Christ has never been heard, rather than where a church has already been started by someone else. <sup>21</sup>I have been following the plan spoken of in the scriptures, where it says, "Those who have never been told about him will see, and those who have never heard of Him will understand."
