WALK TOGETHER CHILDREN 1 Thessalonians 5:12-28 CSB

... speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making music with your heart to the Lord, ²⁰giving thanks always for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹submitting to one another in the fear of Christ.

Ephesians 5:19-21 (CSB)

1. Walk in unity and humility with your <u>LEADERS</u>. (Vs 12-13a, 25)

Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to give recognition to those who labor among you and lead you in the Lord and admonish you, ¹³ and to regard them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves.

1 Thessalonians 5:12-13 (CSB)

Brothers and sisters, pray for us also.

1 Thessalonians 5:25 (CSB)

Obey your leaders and submit to them, since they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account, so that they can do this with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

Hebrews 13:17 (CSB)

2. Walk in unity and humility towards EACH OTHER. (Vs 13b-15, 26)

... and to regard them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves. ¹⁴And we exhort you, brothers and sisters: warn those who are idle, comfort the discouraged, help the weak, be patient with everyone. ¹⁵See to it that no one repays evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good for one another and for all.

1 Thessalonians 5:13-15 (CSB)

Greet all the brothers and sisters with a holy kiss.

1 Thessalonians 5:26 (CSB)

If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Romans 12:18 (CSB)

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves.

Philippians 2:3 (CSB)

3. Walk in unity and humility towards **YOURSELF**. (Vs 16-22, 28)

Rejoice always, ¹⁷pray constantly, ¹⁸give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. ¹⁹Don't stifle the Spirit. ²⁰Don't despise prophecies, ²¹but test all things. Hold on to what is good. ²²Stay away from every kind of evil.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-22 (CSB)

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

1 Thessalonians 5:28 (CSB)

4. Walk in unity and humility <u>UNDER GOD</u>. (Vs 23-24)

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely. And may your whole spirit, soul, and body be kept sound and blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴He who calls you is faithful; he will do it.

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 (CSB)

No temptation has come upon you except what is common to humanity. But God is faithful; he will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to bear it.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (CSB)

Now to him who is able to protect you from stumbling and to make you stand in the presence of his glory, without blemish and with great joy, ²⁵to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, power, and authority before all time, now and forever. Amen.
