1. It doesn't MATTER what you KNOW if you don't KNOW what really MATTERS.

Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.

Deuteronomy 6:4 (NIV)

• DETERMINE and RELATE true PRIORITIES before your children.

And now, O Israel, what does the Lord your God ask of you but to <u>fear</u> the Lord your God, to <u>walk</u> in all his ways, to <u>love</u> him, to <u>serve</u> the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³ and to <u>observe</u> the Lord's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?

Deuteronomy 10:12-13 (NIV)

2. Focus on RELATIONSHIPS more than RULES.

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

Deuteronomy 6:5 (NIV)

• <u>SHOW</u> your children <u>LOVE</u> and they will more readily <u>FOLLOW</u> your rules.

And now a word to you fathers. Don't make your children angry by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction approved by the Lord.

Ephesians 6:4 (NLT)

3. It has to be <u>IN YOU</u> before it can ever be <u>IN THEM</u>.

These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.

Deuteronomy 6:6 (NIV)

• Our children learn more from what they <u>SEE</u> in us than what they <u>HEAR</u> from us.

In everything set them an example by doing what is good.

Titus 2:7 (NIV)

4. There is no substitute for the QUANTITY of QUALITY time.

Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

• Don't miss <u>TEACHABLE MOMENTS</u>, always be prepared for them.
