

PREPARE YE THE WAY  
Luke 19:28-30 CSB

*When he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. <sup>29</sup> As he approached Bethphage and Bethany, at the place called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of the disciples <sup>30</sup> and said, "Go into the village ahead of you. As you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. <sup>31</sup> If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' say this: 'The Lord needs it.'" <sup>32</sup> So those who were sent left and found it just as he had told them. <sup>33</sup> As they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?" <sup>34</sup> "The Lord needs it," they said. <sup>35</sup> Then they brought it to Jesus, and after throwing their clothes on the colt, they helped Jesus get on it. <sup>36</sup> As he was going along, they were spreading their clothes on the road. <sup>37</sup> Now he came near the path down the Mount of Olives, and the whole crowd of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the miracles they had seen: <sup>38</sup> Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven! <sup>39</sup> Some of the Pharisees from the crowd told him, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples." <sup>40</sup> He answered, "I tell you, if they were to keep silent, the stones would cry out."*

1. We Get to MOVE by Faith.

*When he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem.*

*Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout in triumph, Daughter Jerusalem! Look, your King is coming to you; he is righteous and victorious, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.*

2. We Get to SPEAK by Faith.

*... let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed in pure water.*

3. We Get to WORSHIP by Faith.

*Then they brought it to Jesus, and after throwing their clothes on the colt, they helped Jesus get on it. <sup>36</sup> As he was going along, they were spreading their clothes on the road.*

*A very large crowd spread their clothes on the road; others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road.*

Matthew 21:8 (CSB)
