

Willing to find God's Will

Romans 11:33-12:2

Intro: Can we agree that knowing God's will is important?

Can we agree that God has a will for your life? Jer. 29:11

I believe that many don't find God's will for their life bc they aren't willing to find it.

-IF you want to find God's will for your life, I want to give you 3 keys today:

Romans 11:33-12:2

33 Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!

**34 "For who has known the mind of the Lord,
or who has been his counselor?"**

**35 "Or who has given a gift to him
that he might be repaid?"**

36 For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

I. First Key: Realize that God's plan is the best plan v.33-36

-According to these verses, how much does God know?

-More than me!

-His way is better, because His knowledge is better.

-His way is better, because His wisdom is better.

-His way is better, because His resources are more vast.

II. Second Key: Present yourself as a living sacrifice v.1

-If you know God knows everything, and has everything...then FOR CRYING OUT LOUD what are you waiting for?

-Do exactly as He instructs you!

-#1...be a living sacrifice

-#2...be holy and acceptable

-#3...because this is spiritual worship

III. Third Key: Learn to Discern v.2

-When you are in the rebellious zone...you are aware of things that God considers to be Good, Acceptable, and Perfect

-Run towards those things!

-Jesus was accused of being a rebel...he hung out with lepers

-He reached out to fishermen and tax collectors.

-He would not conform to the popularity of His day.

-He was always aware of what was Good, Acceptable, and Perfect in His Father's eyes.

Conclusion:

Do you realize that God's plan is the best plan?

Are you willing to daily be a living, holy, acceptable sacrifice?

Are you committed to being a rebel who seeks out what God considers to be Good, Acceptable, and Perfect?

If so...then you are willing to find God's will....
