Genesis 22:1-19

I. He was tested and found true v.1

Hebrews 11:17-19

17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises was in the act of offering up his only son, 18 of whom it was said, "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named." 19 He considered that God was able even to raise him from the dead, from which, figuratively speaking, he did receive him back.

- We don't always know why God is doing something...but we can trust Him.
- God will take your test and turn it into a testimony! For His glory!

II. He lead in worship v.5

- He took Isaac on a pilgrimage to worship God.
- This trip was all about worshipping God.
- Worshipping God always comes at a cost!
- Worshipping God will cost you...but the gains far out-weigh the immediate costs!
- Lead your families to worship!

III. He trusted God v.8

- God will provide!
 - *Parable of the talents drives me to be faithful with the little I have.
 - I should not complain about my portion, rather be faithful with my portion
 - If I prove myself faithful in the little...God can trust me with more!
- Dads: Trust the Lord. Lead in worship. Pass the test.
 - Dad's who lead their family to Jesus and eternity are the dads who truly win
