## 1. Jesus did it.

- biblical relationship history
  - Genesis 1:26 Let us make man in our image Trinity relational always existed
  - Genesis 2:18 It is not good for man to be alone. The first marriage.
  - Abraham covenant relationship of promise between God and man I will make you a great nation and have a special relationship with God
  - Moses creates laws for that nation love God and Love neighbor
  - Solomon becomes King of that nation and has many relationships 700 wives and 300 concubines - skip that part, don't do that
  - Prophets always calling people back to love God, love your neighbor

- Jesus 12 disciples, sends them out, churches begin
- Paul to other countries to create churches and people meeting in homes
- Revelation marriage supper of the lamb to celebrate our relationships with Jesus and what's more relational than marriage
- Acts to camp out there because it's the age we are in
- Read ch 2:42-47, 5:42
- Acts 2:42-47 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. <sup>43</sup> Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. <sup>44</sup> All the believers were together and had everything in common. <sup>45</sup> They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. <sup>46</sup> Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, <sup>47</sup> praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
- They know to do this because Jesus had taught them how to be connected in relationship
- Acts 5:42 Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah.

- Learning and spiritual maturity is developed in relationships, Jesus did this

- Anatomy of the Soul "Science shows that when a person is honest and relates in conversation with affirming, interested listeners, the person's brain actually goes through a reconfiguration process where it is healed and made stronger. The brain of the person listening is equally affected."
- Secular research: Hardwired to Connect -

- Humans are chemically predisposed to form close relationships.
- Humans are biologically primed to seek moral and spiritual fulfillment.
- As we grow its gonna be harder and harder for you to know many people. Your context will need to be in a small group of people.
- You can't know everyone but everyone can be known. And this is hard.
- 2. It's tough. elephant in the room
  - After acts church at rome, corinth, gal, ephesians phil, col all issues
  - You know what's in my life good, bad and issues, messiness and joy
  - You know what's in our life group the same
  - because being real is messy
  - My history bad environment, bad leader, Bensing (single), Treece, Mine all different
  - Our group 4 calls last year
  - Sometimes I don't want to be there
  - Difficult for new people especially
  - James 1:2-4 Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters,<sup>[a]</sup> whenever you face trials of many kinds, <sup>3</sup> because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.<sup>4</sup> Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
  - Life groups are a safe place to be not be safe.
- 3. It bears fruit. Sometimes i don't want to be there but I go because I'll miss the fruit of what God wants to do in me and i miss the fruit of what he's doing in other's lives.
  - John 15:1,2 I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. <sup>2</sup> He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes<sup>[a]</sup> so that it will be even more fruitful.
  - V. 8 This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

- He's gonna prune you.
