3. Read Mark 15:6-15. What can you discern about Barabbus from the text? What kind of man was he? What was he involved in?
4. How does the exchange of Barabbus (guilty) for Jesus (innocent) paint the spiritual reality of the Gospel?
5. Read a prophecy of Jesus' substitutionary death (Isaiah 53:4-6) and an explanation of Jesus' death (2 Corinthians 5:21). How do these passages explain the substitutionary nature of Jesus' death?
Why was Jesus' death necessary?
6. How does Jesus dying in our place for our sins change our lives in a salvation-sense and an everyday sense?



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
