1. What has shaped your view of marriage the most (parents, grandparents, friends, culture, etc)? Do you believe these influences have led to a more biblical view of marriage?
2. Read Song of Solomon 3:6-11. The big day for the couple has arrived! What observations do you make about the big day? What is important about those observations?
3. What are “columns of smoke” symbolic of? Why is it an important symbol?
4. “Why marry” is one of the most significant questions in our lives. Read Genesis 2:24 and Ephesians 5:31-32. What is Paul’s point by referencing Genesis 2:24 here? What is he teaching?
5.
 - a. Married Couples: In what ways do you believe your marriage reflects the primary purpose of marriage? In what ways does your marriage not reflect the primary purpose of marriage?
 - b. Singles: What married couple has resembled Jesus’ love and sacrifice in a tangible way for you?
6. What is one thing you can do this week that would encourage your marriage or another couple’s marriage to reflect Jesus’ love and faithfulness?
