1. Read Luke 10:25-37. What initial observations do you have about the passage?
2. Luke 10:29 says this about the teacher of the law: "But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, 'And who is my neighbor?'" In what ways do you attempt to justify yourself in order to avoid the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:37-39)?
3. How does defining neighbor as "nearest one" help change the way you look at who your neighbors are?
4. Take out your neighbor or work map and identify which of the following best describes each of your eight "nearest ones" - Stranger, acquaintance, or friends.

Response
