**Luke 19:29-31, 35 (NIV)** - <sup>29</sup>As he approached Bethphage and Bethany at the hill called the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples, saying to them, <sup>30</sup>"Go to the village ahead of you, and as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. <sup>31</sup>If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' say, 'The Lord needs it.'"

<sup>35</sup>They brought it to Jesus, threw their cloaks on the colt and put Jesus on it.

Colossians 1:20b-22 (NLT) - <sup>20b</sup>... You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions. <sup>22</sup>Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault.
