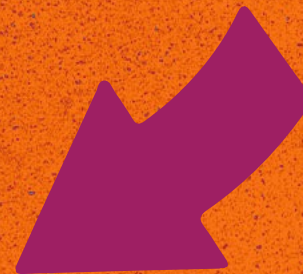

your right hand upholds me.

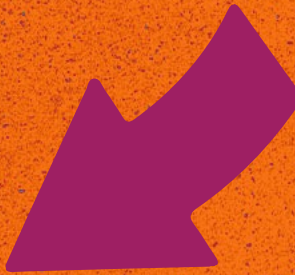

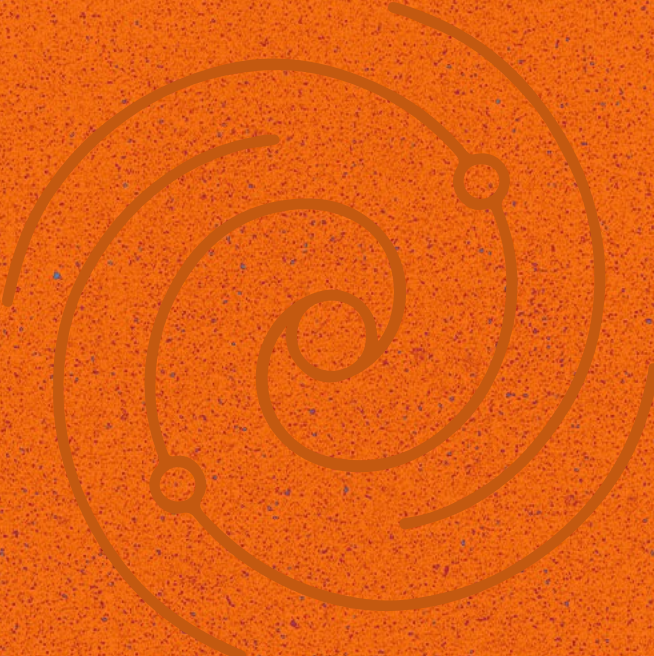

for the mouths of liars will be stopped.

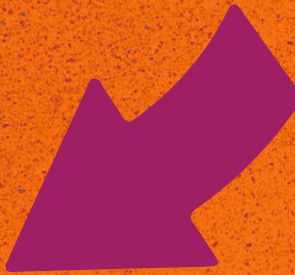

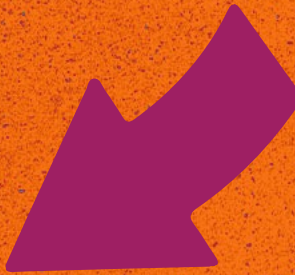
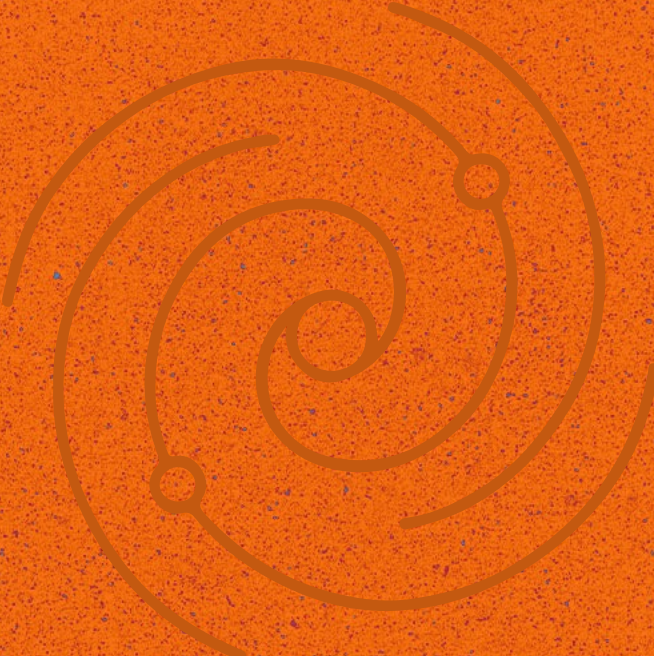
