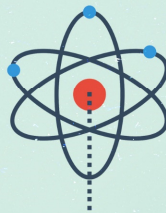

- **THE BIBLE:** 1 Kings 17; 1 Peter 5:7

- **THE BIG IDEA:** It's amazing! God knows what's best for me.
- **THE BIG IDEA:** God does amazing things!
- **THE BIBLE:** 2 Kings 2; John 14:12

WEEK 3

This week, kids will be amazed at how **God spoke to Elijah in a gentle whisper.**

- **THE BIG IDEA:** It's amazing! God speaks to me.
- **THE BIBLE:** 1 Kings 19; John 10:27

WEEK 4

This week, kids will be amazed at how **Elijah goes up to heaven in a chariot of fire.**

Hi Sway Parents and Friends! In Week 3 of Amazed, we looked at how God spoke to Elijah in a gentle whisper. Here was the Big Idea: It's amazing! God speaks to me. Last week we learned about Elijah's encounter with the prophets of Baal. This week, we learn that Jezebel was after Elijah to harm him after God showed himself as the one, true God. Elijah was afraid for his life, so he ran. Not only was he afraid, but Elijah was discouraged; he just wanted to be done with it all. He believed he was the only person left who worshipped the one, true God; and he felt lonely. One night, while spending the night in a cave, God appeared to Elijah –not in the wind, earthquake, or fire –but in a gentle whisper. God wanted to comfort Elijah and remind him that he was not alone—there were 7,000 people who didn't bow down to worship Baal, either. In week 2, God knew what Elijah needed and God provided. This time, God gave Elijah the words Elijah needed to hear.



Sometimes, God wants to speak to us, but there are many distractions that keep us from hearing what God has to say. We may or may not hear God's voice, but God speaks to us in many different ways! So, at bed time, pray this prayer with your child, “God, I am here, I am listening. I want to hear your voice and I want to follow the path You have for my life. I give You all of my worries and fears. God, help me to hear Your voice even when it's hard.

Don't forget to connect with your child this week, and go over our memory verse for this series, Deut 7:21. “The Lord Your God who is with you, He is a great and awesome God.” We hope you review and use the resources made available to you to continue to help your child grow at home this week. Help them learn that **it's amazing how God speaks to me**. That's it, friends. Have a blessed week. See you next time!
