## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Do you have a powerful story where God turned your life upside down or is your story boring? Does it matter?
2. Read 1 Timothy 1:12-16. What was Paul like before Christ? Why is it important for Paul to remember and share his story with others?
3. Verse 15 was a common phrase used among Christians at the time. What does this statement teach us?
4. What was God's purpose in transforming Paul's life according to verse 16? What is God's purpose in transforming you?
5. How have you seen the Lord use your story to encourage someone else in Christ or to lead someone to Christ?
6. Read Acts 7:54-60. What was Saul's/Paul's part in the death of Stephen? What impact would Stephen's testimony and martyrdom have had on you if you were in Saul's sandals?
7. Read Acts 9:1-6. Describe Saul's purpose in life before he met Christ. What did Jesus do to get Saul's attention in order to save him?
8. How humbled do you imagine Saul was when Jesus appeared to him? What regret do you sense Saul would have felt at the moment Jesus revealed himself to Saul?
9. Please share the most amazing testimony of someone you know.
10. Read Acts 9:20-22. After being ministered to by Ananias and spending time with other followers of Jesus in Damascus, what did Saul then do immediately? What has the Holy Spirit given you passion for? What keeps you from living out that passion more faithfully?
11. Why does it matter if you share your story of how God saved you? Who has the Lord laid upon your heart to share your story with?
