3. Read Revelation 17:8. What comfort do you experience in knowing God had your name in the Book of Life, if you are a Christ follower, since before the creation of the world?
4. Define amillennialism, postmillennialism and premillennialism. What have you been taught about these views in the past?
5. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17. What do these verses teach us about Christ’s second coming?
6. Read Revelation 20:1-8. What does this passage say about God’s power over the devil?
7. Read Revelation 20:11-15. What has God saved His children from? What about God’s character demands that He punishes sin to this degree?
8. Why does it seem to us that others do not have consequences for their sins? Are there consequences for EVERY sin we commit? Please explain your answer.
9. Read Revelation 21:1-4. How do these verses encourage you when you reflect upon your eternal destiny? Discuss the contrast of the eternal futures of followers of Jesus versus those who reject Him.
10. How much easier is it for you to praise God through your worship, witness and service to Him when you reflect upon the eternal life that He has provided for you?
11. Who will you invest in and invite to church this month? To whom will you be accountable?
