3. Read Numbers 27:18-23. How do you think this experience impacted both Joshua and the Israelites?
4. Read Joshua 1:1-9. What was God's call and promise to Joshua and the Israelites? How does that call and promise apply to you?
5. In verses 5 & 6, God states that he will be with Joshua, then tells Joshua that no one will be able to stand against him. Why is the order of the Lord's statements important?
6. Joshua seemed to be content with his role at each point of his life. Why can you be content in your current station in life?
7. In verses 7-9 how were obedience and success connected?
8. How can you be expectant of the Lord's work through your life in 2019, while knowing this is not heaven?
9. Read Joshua 1:10-18. How did Joshua go about getting others involved and on mission? What steps can you take to involve others in God's mission whom you are in relationship with?
10. How faithful were the Israelites to God and to Moses' leadership as they were led out of Egypt and in the desert? How might have you taken the commitment of the Israelites to Joshua in verse 16-18 if you were in his sandals?
