1. Share a time in which something unexpectedly good happened to you.
2. **Read Ruth 2:1-3.** What was Ruth's response to her difficult circumstances? How do her actions inspire you?
3. Was Ruth running into Boaz a coincidence or a divine appointment? Do you believe there is such a thing as a "coincidence?" Explain why.
4. When have you seen God use so-called "coincidences" in your life?
5. **Read Leviticus 23:22.** Why would the Lord give such a command to His people?
6. **Read Ruth 2:4-7.** What did Ruth ask to do? How did this reflect her place in society?
7. **Read Ruth 2:8-9.** What does Boaz instruct Ruth to do? What is Boaz doing for Ruth?
8. When have you felt like an outsider? How do Boaz's actions remind you of Christ's work for you?
9. **Read Ruth 2:10-12.** Why would Ruth be so surprised by Boaz's kindness? What does Ruth's statement say about her character?
10. How does a humble attitude help us receive God's blessings?
11. **Read Galatians 6:7-9.** What does this passage teach us about receiving from God?
12. What encouraged you the most from this study? How does this study help you to understand how God is working in your life?
